## **INDOOR CLIMBING CENTRE RULES**

## These rules define conditions of entry and must be abided by to be permitted use of the facilities at The Hangout.

- All participants **MUST** complete and sign The Hangout Climbing Agreement.
- All Participants **MUST** complete The Hangouts safety induction prior to climbing and it must be administered by a Hangout staff member. **You MUST NOT induct your friends**.
- All Participants must present their Term Membership Cards or make payment at Reception prior to climbing.
- All Participants must abide by all reasonable instruction given by all of The Hangout Staff.
- **NO SOLOING** or unroped climbing is permitted.
- Persons under the influence of **ALCOHOL OR NON-PRESCRIPTION DRUGS** are not permitted to climb or belay under any circumstances.
- **NO** belaying lying down or sitting on chairs, all belayers must clip in correctly and remain standing.
- Children under 14 years of age unless participating in a climbing session supervised by gym staff must be supervised by a parent or guardian.
- Personal harnesses and all safety equipment must be commercial products designed for climbing. Rescue, tree lopper, equipment etc is not permitted.
- Shoes must be worn, **NO BAREFOOT** climbing permitted.
- NO RUNNING in or around The Hangout centre or its car park area.
- Please keep all **FOOD AND DRINK** off the safety matted area.
- NO SMOKING within the climbing gym or its car parking area.
- The Hangout is not responsible for lost or stolen articles. Lockers are available for your use.
- Lead climbers must display The Hangouts lead pass clearly on their harness at all times when using the lead wall. Please see **LEAD WALL USE RULES**.
- Boulderers must take responsibility for not climbing beyond their ability, ensuring their own safety and the safety of others.
- Climbers deemed to be climbing, belaying or behaving in an UNSAFE OR DANGEROUS MANNER may be asked to leave.
- The Hangout is a family friendly centre. **FOUL LANGUAGE or OFFENSIVE BEHAVIOUR** will not be tolerated.
- The Hangout reserves the right to expel any participant judged unsafe or acting offensively.
